Hello there dear, What is your name?


He sat with Elphy feeling blue

I will accompany you from start to fin.




As he walked ahead, he saw a giant heap of mud

He had a big happy smile on his face.




He had the most wonderful time  
Making new friends and learning his name.




‘Wohoo!’ he exclaimed

The best any kid had - ever!*








What an adventurous day this little boy had
