




“Dorian and Alena work so good together,” said Sunil. “No matter what they do together, they do well.”

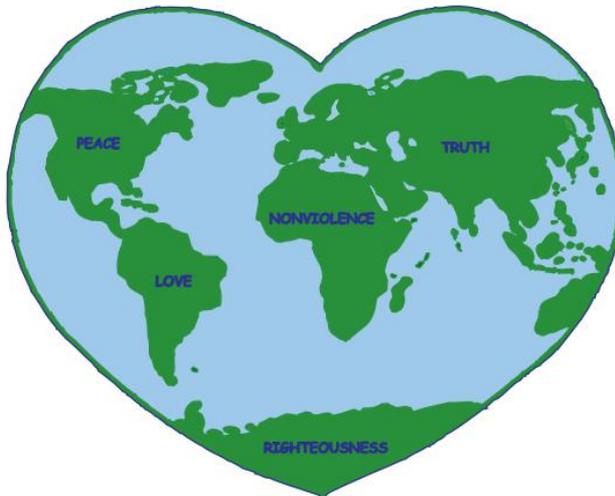
